Jan 3 Lk 5:20-21 When Jesus saw their faith, he said, “Friend, your sins are forgiven.” The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, “Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?”

Jan 10 Heb 7:24 but because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood.

Jan 17 1 Cor 8:9 Be careful, however, that the exercise of your rights does not become a stumbling block to the weak.

Jan 24 Dan 4:35 All the peoples of the earth are regarded as nothing. He does as he pleases with the powers of heaven and the peoples of the earth. No one can hold back his hand or say to him: “What have you done?”

Jan 31 Micah 7:18 Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy.

Feb 7 Josh 11:20 For it was the LORD himself who hardened their hearts to wage war against Israel, so that he might destroy them totally, exterminating them without mercy, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Feb 14 Acts 7:51 “You stiff-necked people! Your hearts and ears are still uncircumcised. You are just like your ancestors: You always resist the Holy Spirit!”

Feb 21 Lam 3:38 Is it not from the mouth of the Most High that both calamities and good things come?

Feb 28 Lam 3:33 For he does not willingly bring affliction or grief to anyone.

Mar 7 Lam 3:37 Who can speak and have it happen if the Lord has not decreed it?

Mar 14 Dt 5:29 Oh, that their hearts would be inclined to fear me and keep all my commands always, so that it might go well with them and their children forever!

Mar 21 Prov 21:1 In the LORD’s hand the king’s heart is a stream of water that he channels toward all who please him.

Mar 28 Jer 18:8 and if that nation I warned repents of its evil, then I will relent and not inflict on it the disaster I had planned.

Apr 11 Jer 18:6 He said, “Can I not do with you, Israel, as this potter does?” declares the LORD. “Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand, Israel.

Apr 18 Num 23:19 God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

Apr 25 Gen 6:6 The LORD regretted that he had made human beings on the earth, and

his heart was deeply troubled.

May 2 1 Sam 15:29 He who is the Glory of Israel does not lie or change his mind; for he is not a human being, that he should change his mind.

May 9 Acts 14:17 Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown kindness by giving you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts with joy.

May 16 Job 31:4 Does he not see my ways and count my every step?

May 23 Prov 3:19 By wisdom the LORD laid the earth's foundations, by understanding he set the heavens in place;

May 30 Heb 4:13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

June 6 1 Chr 28:9 And you, my son Solomon, acknowledge the God of your father, and serve him with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind, for the LORD searches every heart and understands every desire and every thought. If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will reject you forever.

June 13 Isa 63:10 Yet they rebelled and grieved his Holy Spirit. So he turned and became their enemy and he himself fought against them.

June 20 Gen 20:6 Then God said to him in the dream, "Yes, I know you did this with a clear conscience, and so I have kept you from sinning against me. That is why I did not let you touch her."

June 27 Prov 1:24-26 But since you refuse to listen when I call and no one pays attention when I stretch out my hand, 25 since you disregard all my advice and do not accept my rebuke, 26 I in turn will laugh when disaster strikes you; I will mock when calamity overtakes you—
